COURSE OFFERINGS

At Joseph S. Clark Preparatory High School we strive to meet the needs of each of our students. In addition to offering two diploma options (University and Career), we provide students with the resources needed to be successful at any level. We want each student to have the opportunity to secure post-secondary placements in college and careers most suitable for their individual skills, interests and abilities.

- Developmental and remedial courses are offered during freshmen and sophomore years for students who need support in high school courses. We also offer developmental and first-year college courses to juniors and seniors to ensure readiness for the rigors of a four-year college education.
- Students at or above grade-level can pursue an accelerated pathway to graduation that includes dual-enrollment and career courses and internship opportunities to maximize students' post-secondary options. More ambitious students have the opportunity to earn an Associate's Degree from a two-year college or multiple career certifications while still in high school.
- We also provide non-native English speakers and students with special needs support to overcome language and other non-academic barriers to success.
