On behalf of The RobertBobb Group, we would appreciate it greatly if you could address the following questions for our clarification as we prepare our proposal.

Thank you

1. What are the salaries of the principals in each school?

The proposal is for services at Joseph S. Clark only the salary of the Director is currently \$100,000.

2. We ask clarification of the services statement: "The primary obligation of the Proposer is to operate its affairs so that FirstLine will be assured of continuous, reliable service and such that FirstLine is not burdened with day-to-day operations."

We expect to supervise the contractor and the contractor is expected to provide the day to day management of the school leader.

a. Is FirstLine requiring a full-time (100%) individual to supervise the principals and all operations?

a. Please provide your professional opinion of whether it should be full time or part time

b. Is FirstLine seeking an onsite individual on a part-time basis (20 hrs a week) to be on-site and available?

c. Do the operations extend into the business affairs? Budget, inventory, payroll etc? Or limited to school operations at the sites?

a. Non-academic aspects of the school will be handled by the FLS business office .

d. D. Is there an estimated budget set aside for this one-year engagement?

We have an amount projected however we are expecting proposers to provide what they believe it will cost to properly support the school.

e. The RFP speaks to "We also require at least 75% of the people employed under our contract to be full time employees."

Does this refer to the consultants being 75% employed directly by consulting firm?

Because consultants are normally relatively well compensated you can disregard this requirement.

3. Please explain in more detail what is meant in the RFP as "Service Implementation Plan

- a. Requirements as Listed in This RFP: Staffing, Vans, etc.
- b. Policies and Procedures as Listed in this RFP: Substitutes, Accidents, etc.
- c. Transportation Service Plan: Dispatch, Scheduling, Maintenance, etc.
- d. Routing Plan: Route Creation, Data Management, etc.
- e. Alignment with Start-Up Schedule
