



Questions & Responses for HRMS/HRIS RFP Process

Question #1. The RFP states that they are keeping Paychex, however p. 7 states that they are seeking Payroll processing, and p. 3 states that payroll modules are to go live July 2019. Is the intent of the RFP for a complete Employee Resource Planning system with HR and Finance or solely a Human Resource/Talent Management System?

Answer: Our intent is to consider a full suite of options available via the proposers HRMS/HRIS. We would prefer one suite of software to provide these functions. We are currently most interested in a unified system that will provide demographic/general HRIS functionality along with payroll and recruitment/employee application process functionality. We are not looking for a finance system and are not likely to currently utilize a performance management module.

Question #2. Are all employees, in the other 6 locations, paid under a single FEIN tax ID?

Answer: Yes.

Question #3. Will this bid include the Admin office only?

Answer: No. This software will service our entire organization.

Question #4. Are companies from outside USA eligible to apply for this? (like ,from India or Canada)

Answer: if selected as a finalist, FirstLine would need to substantiate how a non-US vendor would provide a better option/service than a US-vendor for public funding purposes. We would prefer a US-based vendor.

Question #5. Do we need to come over there for meetings?

Answer: There may be times in the implementation plan that on-site assistance is needed (particularly for training staff) - however we are open to remote support as long as it is of a high quality and supports the needs noted in the RFP.

Question #6. Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (like, from India or Canada)

Answer: Please see answers to #4 and #5.

Question #7. Can we submit the proposals via email?

Answer: Yes, proposals are to be submitted via email to rcain@firstlineschools.org. One electronic copy of all documents (via email or USB device) is required, a hand-delivered or mailed copy to our office is optional. Submissions are required to be provided by Monday, November 26, 2018 at 3:00 PM CST.

Question #8. Are proposers required to integrate with your existing systems (Paychex, Taleo, Liazon etc.) or are the schools willing to consider other options?

Answer: See answer to #1

Question #9. What data do you want to feed over to Blackbaud? Demographic info? General ledger info? Payroll data?

Answer: Payroll and general ledger data.

Question #10. Is a proposer required to currently have an integration with Blackbaud or can they be willing to build a connection? We have our own development team and are always eager to build integrations.

Question #11. Please confirm if the following are mandatory requirements/noncompliance puts the bidder in a disadvantage:

- Principal of Business and Registered Office in Orleans Parish as listed with the Louisiana Secretary of State.
- Experience in the education industry in New Orleans (Pre-K through College)

Answer: For the Orleans Parish and DBE sections, if neither apply to your business, you will receive a "0" in that section, but will not be disqualified.

Question #12. We do not have a presence in Orleans/Louisiana. Will having a presence in Orleans/Louisiana be considered a showstopper or will that put us into a significant disadvantage.
