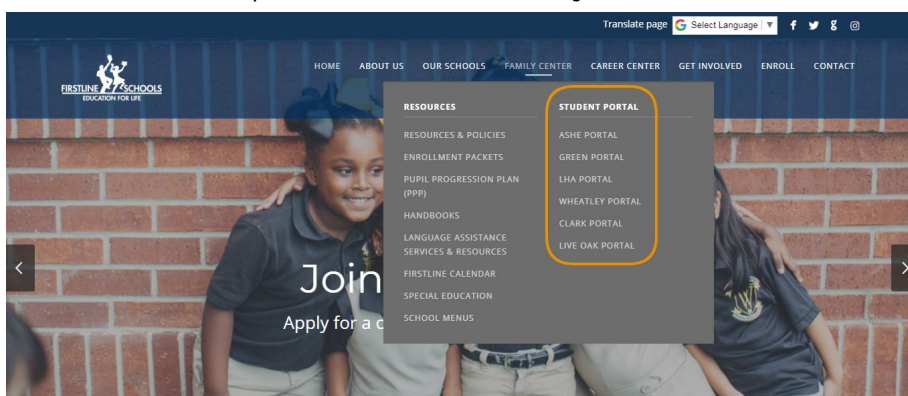


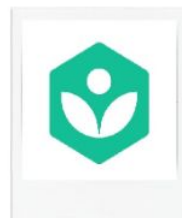
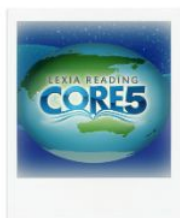
Continue Your Learning @ Home

2 Select your school's student portal under the family center tab.



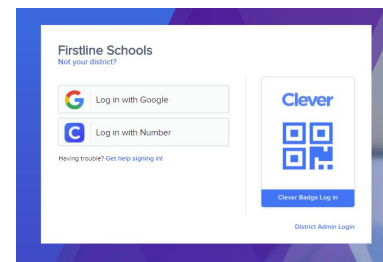
3 Click on the application you would like to access.



4 Click login with Number. Students can login with their username and password with their login number.

Username = K = 6 digit student number
1-8 = 6 digit student number + .fl
(ex. 123456.fl)

Password = K-4 = book OR book1234
5-8 birthdate written as MMDDYYYY

ST Math

Who uses it?

All K-4th students

What is it for?

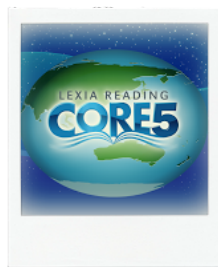
In ST Math students solve visual puzzles to build an understanding of math concepts. It is great for problem solving!

How do students make progress?

Students complete puzzles to help the penguin named Jiji, get across the screen. Progress is measured in “percentage syllabus progress”.

How can parents support it?

Ask your students “How are you doing on Jiji?” and “Tell me about the puzzle you are solving.”



LexiaCore5

Who uses it?

All K-4th grade students

What is it for?

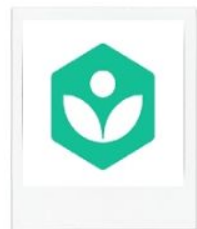
LexiaCore5 gives students practice with foundational reading skills including phonics, fluency, morphology, vocabulary, and reading comprehension.

How do students make progress?

Lexia has 18 total levels. Each level is in a different part of the world and have five activities for students to complete. Each activity has 10-20 units to complete.

How can parents support it?

Ask your students: “What level are you working on in Lexia?” “How many more units do you have until the next level?” “Show me your Lexia certificates.”



Khan Academy

Who uses it?

All 6-8th grade students

What is it for?

Khan Academy provides practice exercises, instructional videos, and a personalized learning dashboard that empower learners to study at their own pace.

How do students make progress?

Students practice by clicking on the Course Mastery. Students can redo exercises until they reach 100%. NOTE: Please make sure students are clicking on and working on “My course mastery” and NOT “Assignments” when at home.

How can parents support it?

Encourage your students to practice at home! Ask them: “Can I see your Profile page?” and “What how does this connect to what you are learning in class?”
