



How to use Primary English Language Arts Resources

Kindergarten through Second Grade

- ❑ Read the CKLA program overview to develop your knowledge on how kindergarteners, first and second graders are learning how to read.
- ❑ Ask your student's teacher what unit they are studying to select the corresponding book to have student read out loud. Re-reading one of the stories several times is encouraged!
- ❑ Read the guidance at the top of the "tricky words" list to create flashcards using the list of words. Students should read these words automatically similar to multiplication facts.

Third and Fourth Grade

- ❑ Read the module overview to develop your understanding of what students are studying in class.
- ❑ Use the text summary to build your understanding of the books students are reading in class.
- ❑ Use the text summary to ask students questions about the books they are reading in class.
- ❑ Check out books from the local library that students are reading in class so that they can read them at home. Note that teachers may have a copy students can take home.
