Staff and Family Refresh Day

On Friday, April 3rd we will not have any of our distance learning programs for the day. It is important to us that our staff and you, our families, take a day to relax and refresh. Distance learning will start again on Monday, April 6th. We will also not have distance learning classes during our regularly scheduled spring break, on April 9th - 13th.

Distance Learning Second Packet

The second distance learning packets are being mailed out this week. You should receive the packets in your mail by this Thursday (March 26th). If you do not receive your packet by Thursday afternoon, you may pick them up at your school on Friday (March 27th). Please note that in order to follow the "Stay at Home" mandate, we will have a table set up in front of the school for you to grab a packet. We will also have a sign with a phone number to call should you have any questions.

Update to Citywide Feeding Sites

NOLA Public Schools are condensing the weekly schedule at the Citywide Feeding Program sites to multiple days of meals during specific daily time frames. See the updated schedule below:

- This Week
 - Meals for both Thursday and Friday will be served on **Thursday, March 26 from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.**
 - Community Feeding Sites will **NOT** be open on Friday, March 27.
- Next Week and Moving Forward:
 - Starting on Monday, March 30 – **every Monday**, meals will be provided for **two days from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.**
 - Every **Wednesday**, meals will be provided for **three days**. Moving forward Community Feeding sites will **NOT** be open on Tuesday, Thursday or Friday.
