



Dear FirstLine Families,

The second quarter of the school year will begin on October 13th. It is important that you fill out our [Q2 Learning and Transportation Options form](#) so that we may plan for how your student will attend school in the second quarter. If you select to have your student continue with our distance learning program, they will not be able to attend in-person learning until the next quarter which will start in January 2021.

Please note:

- You must fill out this form even if you completed the 1st quarter version of this form. **PLEASE COMPLETE THIS SURVEY FOR EACH CHILD** who attends a FirstLine school.
- Each quarter, families will be given the option to choose virtual (at home) learning for their child(ren) for the whole quarter. This means not sending your student(s) to school in person.
- Families will also have the option to opt-out of school bus service for the quarter if their student is attending school in-person. This means bringing your child(ren) to school yourself.
- Due to the changes each quarter, your student's teachers might change.
- We need time to prepare for your student(s). Please commit to your decision and submit by **noon on Sunday, September 27th**.
- For middle school students, we expect a return to in-person learning via the hybrid model communicated earlier in the year, beginning sometime in October. We will be announcing the start date in the next one to two weeks.
- If we do not hear from you, we reserve the right to use your learning and transportation preferences from Quarter 1.
